

## Guidance on Client Contributions

We rely heavily on client contributions to be able to deliver our service and keep our charity operational.

We receive some funding from the Scottish Government, and continually apply for grants to help run and develop our service.

It takes two and a half years to train each Relationships Scotland accredited counsellor. When they qualify they continue with regular professional external supervision and mandatory on-going training to maintain their standards, in line with COSCA, their Professional Body.

We have provided some guidance on counselling contributions below and would be grateful if you would consider a contribution that is reasonable for you, for each appointment held.

Nobody will be excluded from receiving help if they are struggling financially, and cannot contribute what they would like, and we can also waive contributions if necessary.

Above £60,000	£65 per appointment
£50,000 - £60,000	£55 per appointment
£40,000 - £50,000	£45 per appointment
£30,000 - £40,000	£35 per appointment
£20,000 - £30,000	£25 per appointment
Less than £20,000	£20 per appointment
Unemployed	£10 per appointment
